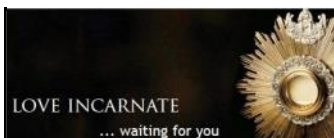

Updated Pandemic Practices

Alternately, remember that we have the 5 pm Parking Lot Mass at St. Al’s, and this is **EXTREMELY** low risk because you stay in your own vehicle.
